

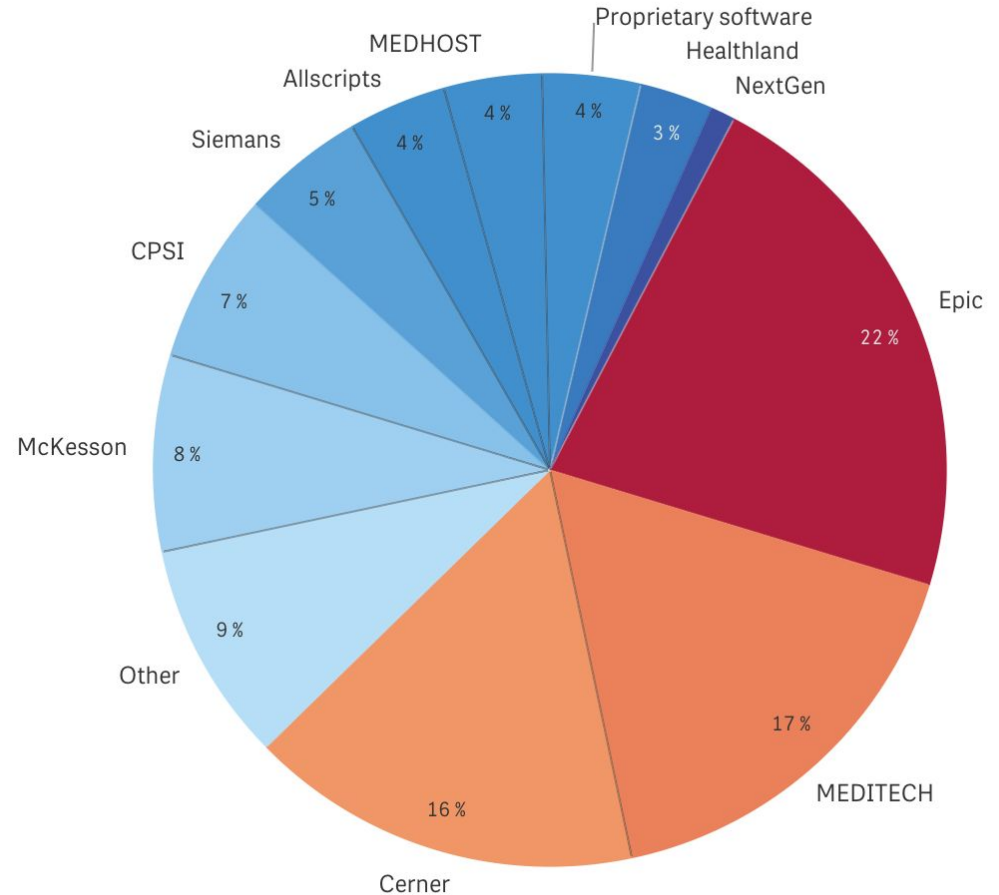

EHR landscape

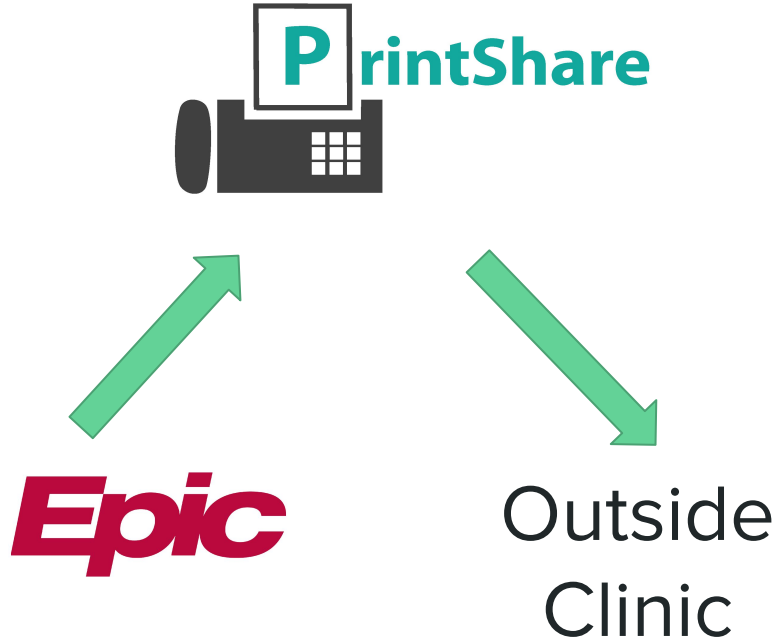
Among inpatient settings, **Epic has 22%** of the market, followed by MEDITECH and Cerner.

Target Market

- 25,750 outpatient clinics
- 5,627 hospitals
- **Target = 10%**

Venue

- \$50 monthly fee
- +\$0.50 per patient per month
- Bulk pricing

Our Costs

- AWS (\$25k/month)
- Software developers (\$100k each)
- Marketing (\$100k)
- HR (\$100k)

Total Monthly Profit = ~\$4M/month
